# REACH CME BY FOGSI

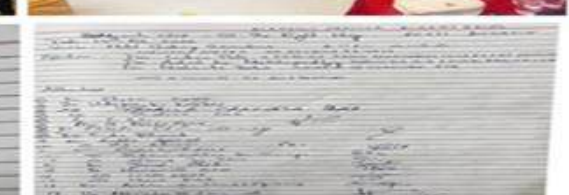
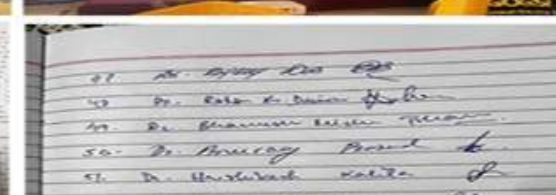
